In this issue we are continuing the publication of the 1860 Wayne Co. Census & the 1st marriage register. Most of the students have finished their assignments re: the other census for Wayne Co. & I hope to be able to start sorting & typing them within the month. We may be able to do this by computer through the college or possibly by a young man who is interested in genealogy & who has his own computer.

This past week I received from Mrs. Ethel T. Elliott, a copy of the Carteret Historical Research Ass. publication, The Researcher. We may be exchanging newsletters with them on a regular basis. If any of our members are interested, they are publishing a Carteret Co. Cemetery Book, cost \$8 & can be ordered by writing the Association at Box 1722, Beaufort, N.C. 28516. It is a limited publication so if you are interested do put your order in at once.

Work on our book The Lost Town of Goldsboro is coming along nicely & is growing in scope. We are fortunate to be able to include the work of Mr. John Baxton Flowers III, of Mt. Olive & Durham, He has kindly given us permission to use his work & has offered to help us in any way he can.

Beginning in the Jan. issue of the Trails we will publish queries of the members so if you have not sent yours in please do so at once. We would also like to have copies of family bible records to publish as well as any article that our members would contribute.

I am happy to announce that Mrs. Donna Burke has been assigned, by the library, as the Local History & Genealogy librarian. We are delighted that the growth of interest in our "addiction" has resulted in Donna's appointment. We hope that Donna will be able to be our guest at the Jan. meeting so that you may meet her.

I regret to inform you that the National Archives, as of Dec. 10th will no longer provide inter-library loan of census microfilm. We in N.C. are lucky in that our N.C. State Archives has the microfilm of other states census through 1880, with the exception of N.Y. & we only have that through 1850. At this time the National Archives is looking into the idea of a private firm loaning the microfilm for a fee. National Archives is also changing their policy re: military records. In the past you ordered a record & were billed for it at the time you got the record, now you will be notified of the cost of the record before they will send it to you. Also the basic cost has gone from \$3 to \$5. National has also announced the cutting of 781 full time positions by mid-Feb.

I have made arrangements with Per-Flo Tours for a research trip to Washington, D.C. for 11 Apr. -16 Apr. The cost will be \$260 per person & that will include round trip transportation to Washington, transportation in Washington, & 6 nights in the motel. On

our last trip to Washington we stayed in the same motel. Each of the rooms has a furnished kitchen so that you can fix your own breakfast if you so choose. If you are interested in joining the group please let me know by Jan 15th. We will have guided tours of the National Archives, Library of Congress, DAR Library, Colonial Dames Library & the National Genealogical Society Library. National Archives & Library of Congress are open at night so that you can get lots of research done.

POWERS OF ATTORNEY

In trying to find what happened to siblings of your ancestors have you remembered to check the powers of attorney? These can be found in the deed books & are listed as P.A.'s in the deed index. For the last couple of weeks I have been working on abstracting the P.A.'s of Wayne Co. and interestingly enough the majority prove migration out of Wayne Co. and several have proved 3 generations of descendents. I am enclosed a few to give you an idea of what they contain.

Bk 18 p 115

Silas Andrews & wife Charity of Gibson Co., Tenn. appoint Solomon Bradbury of Wayne Co., N.C. as lawful attorney to sell land which Charity as a child & legal heir of John Worrell, dec'd, late of Wayne Co., was willed. date 6 Nov 1838. Recorded in Feb. Term of Ct. 1839.

Bk. 19 p. 368

Elisha Aycock of Houston Co., Ga. appoints Irving Aycock of Randolph Co., Ga. to recover from Timothy or Simon Aycock of Wayne Co., N.C. such legacy bequeathed him by his grandfather, Jesse Aycock. dated 2 Dec 1842. Recorded Aug. Term Ct. 1844

Lemuel Bird of Stewart Co., Ga. in right of his wife Susan Bird late Susan McCullen dau. & one of the heirs of Ashur McCullen late of Wayne Co., N.C. dec'd appoints Ann McCullen of Wayne Co., N.C. attorney to receive from Joseph Everett of Wayne Co., N.C. Guardian of Ashur McCullen heirs, all monies due him from the estate dated 21 Oct 1834 Recorded Aug. Term Ct. 1837

Joseph Bardin & Penelope his wife, late Penelope Newsom, dau. of Joel Newsom & Haney his wife, who was dau. to Jesse Aycock late of Wayne Co., N.C., appoints Isaac Bradshaw all of Adair Co., Ky attorney to sell a tract of land in Wayne Co. devised by sd. Jesse Aycock to the sd. Penelope Bardin, his grand daughter & receive from Simon Aycock her former guardian all sums she is entitled to. dated 3 Sept 1838. Recorded Nov. Term Ct. 1841

Bk 22 p 141

Isaac B. Norman & Louisa his wife formerly Louisa Musgrave, Harrison Rogers & Mary his wife, Sally Ann Copeland, Jas. Rogers & Caroline his wife (all being Dau. of Iasiah Musgrave dec'd late of Wayne Co., N.C.) appoints Needham Perkins of Wayne Co., N.C. to collect all due them from the estate of Nathan Pike late of Wayne Co., N.C. dec'd, whether willed them by Nathan Pike as heirs of Arcade Musgrave, wife of Iasiah Musgrave, dec'd & dau. of ad. Nathan Pike & to receipt Thomas Edgerton for the same. (All the above of Vigo Co. Ind) dated 22 Feb 1851

These P.A.'s of Wayne Co. will be published by early spring.
