Dear Members,

With some lovely days coming along I can almost believe spring will soon be here! We are fortunate not to have suffered the winter that parts of the country have had.

Some of you may have seen the Heritage of Lenoir Co. that Hunter Publishing Co. did for their committee. If you have seen it you know that it is a "top-of-the-line" publication. Hunter will also be doing our book & our working relationship is excellent.

We would like to urge each & every member of our society to submit a story on their family for inclusion in the book. A form will be on the last page of the news letter for you to send in to the committe. We are asking that you send in these forms so that we may know how many stories we can expect & on what families. The address of the committee is also on the last page. I am also including for you some guide lines when doing your family history.

We continue the 1860 Wayne Co. Census in this issue and also the marriage register I hope you are saving your issues of the news letter as it will give you your own copy of the records that we publish.

Currently my morning class students & I are working on the powers of attorney of the county & we are finding many interesting things. Many of them show migration of family members & proof of relationship. The night class will be abstracting the bastan bonds of the county.

Several socities in other parts of the state have written & asked about exchanging newsletters with us. We will be getting the Buncombe Co., Carterete Co. & the Johnston Co. newsletters & as soon as they begin publishing, the newly formed Wake Co. society.

Some of you may not know that I am now teaching three classes in Johnston Co. & the students there have almost finished abstracting the 1867-1896 marriage registers. Johnston Tech. will type the abstracts & I will have a copy for the Wayne Co. Local History Room. If you have Johnston Co. connections I do hope you have availed yourself of the fine collection in the Johnston Co. Room.

In a move to save the society an added expense we have decided to stop sending

out postcard notices of the meetings. The cards will go out for the April meeting but not there after. I'm enclosing a list of the meeting days for the rest of the year. Please mark them on your calender right now so that you won't forget them. I would like to take this opportunity to thank our corresponding secretary, Ms. Peggy Day for the outstanding job she had in getting the meeting notices out each month.

NOTES FOR FAMILY HISTORIES

How to cite your sources:

It is not necessary to cite chapter & verse but just a brief listing of your sources such as: census records, wills, deeds, birth, death, & marriage records, family bibles, family tradition, tombstones.

We would like for you to use the story form of writing when ever possible as it will make your story more interesting than a dry recounting of dates. If for instant you know of a family story concerning an ancestor, perhaps a story about your War Between The States ancestor. Remember that what you recount will be a permanent record of your family.

Please limit your story to three (3) pages, typed, double-spaced PER GENERATION. The Hertiage Committe will not be responsible for typing your story, if you don't type or don't have a typewriter you can probably contact the business department of Wayne Community Colleg & have a student type it for you for a small fee.

Mr. Hall Kirkman will be the photographer for the Hertiage Committe. We realized that many of you will not want to send your old photographs to Winston-Salem, in which case Mr. Kirkman will copy them for you & if you want will make a negative for you.

We will have proof readers & we will correct obvious grammitical mistakes but if your story is written in dialetic we will not change it. Any changes will be brought to your attention.

In the event that more than one person submits a story on the same ancestor you will be notified so that you may co-author the story.

The hours that the staff will be in the library will be published in the News Argus & you may call or come by if you have questions or want to turn in your story.
