1840 U.S. CENSUS OF STEWART COUNTY, GEORGIA

The 1840 U.S. Census of Stewart Co., GA is continued here from our November 1987 newsletter. It was given to us by Francis Deans who feels that a great many people from Wayne Co. moved on to Stewart Co., GA. It comes from a book called the History of Stewart County.

In the 1840 U.S. Census only the names of heads of families were recorded. The number beside the name indicates the number of persons living in the household, which included employees, relatives, etc. in addition to wife and children.
