## HOLLOMAN HISTORY

submitted by William H. Chandler

The object of this sketch is to arrange in chronological order as much history as I have been able to collect of the ancestors of my maternal grandparents, Silas and Sarah Holloman.

I have not been able to trace the ancestry to the first who came from England but know they were of English decent. In reading Baptist history, I find that Roger Williams was Baptized in 1636 by one Ezekiel Holloman. I am not able to establish the lineage back to him but believe he was an ancestor as the name Ezekiel was a family name in their family. Then too, while neither of them ever united with any church, all the ancestors we have any account of were all Baptist. There was an ancestor, a Doctor Jenkins, also a Bettie Jenkins (who was either his wife or daughter), who came from England. I think he was Silas Holloman I's great-great grandfather. My mother (Judith Holloman) has told me of seeing a pair of tongs that was brought from England by Dr. Jenkins. They were in the possession of great Aunt Annie McLendon at her death.

Grandfather and grandmother were first cousins. I do not know who her maternal grandparents were but think her grandmother was Judith Wimbelly. Grandfathers grandparents were Benton Moore and Easter Barnes. I know only of one child born to them, Annie Moore. As they were cousins, their grandparents were Silas Holloman I and Jane (Gleuhan, Glavhan, Glavghan or Glaughan). They had several children, but only know the names of three: Jerry - Ezekiel - Silas Holloman II.

- Silas Holloman I and Jane (Glauhan, Glavhan, Glaughan, or Glavghan) Children: Jerry - Ezekiel - Silas II
  - Jerry Holloman Do not know who he married but know he had a son by the name of Eli Holloman.
  - Ezekiel Holloman married Jerusha King. (I think her mother was Judith Wimbally). Ezekiel lived in N.C. I do not know how long he lived there, but he was living there in 1821. Children were: Dick, Malachi, John, Ezekiel, Judith, Annie, and Sarah (born in ?, who was my grandmother) -I do not know who the boys married but know that Judith and annie married brothers by the name of Bass. Judith Bass and husband moved to Ala. After he died, she married a Jetson Green. Sarah - married her cousin Silas Holloman III.

Silas Holloman II - married Annie Moore, the daughter of Easter and Benton Moore. Children were: Benton, Gillis, Silas, Easter, Penelope Moore, and Annie. Benton and Gillis - have no record of who they married Easter - married a Waters - she weighed over two hundred pounds - when a catamount attacked her, she crushed it to death under her knees. Penelope Moore - never married - was called Aunt Penny. Annie - youngest - married Dennis McKendon - they lived in Kershaw County S.C. in 1882 - Children were: Hampton, Jesse, Gillis and Annie Silas III - born Oct. 19, 1790 - he married Sarah Holloman (born in 1796) daughter of Silas III's Uncle Ezekiel - which made them first cousins.

### SILAS HOLLOMAN III AND SARAH HOLLOMAN

They ran away and married in May 1821 and settled near Timmonsville, Darlington "Co., S.C. His occupation was that of a farmer and owned slaves. He also held the office of Magistrate several years. Among his slaves was a faithful and much loved servant by the name of Sarah. Aunt Sallie or Mammy, as we children called her, was given to my mother (Judith) when she married, John Hood Wilson. After negroes were freed, she refused to leave them and moved to Texas with them. She helped raise us children and was living with a married sister of mine and helping to raise her children when she died at the age of 85, Grimes Co., Bedias, Texas in April 1880. After the death of Sarah Holloman in Jan. 19, 1851, Silas married a Mahala Vaun, Vann, or Vaughn. I have no date of this marriage. There was one child born to them but have no more information about the child. His second wife died before his death. He died Feb. 5, 1857. He was on a visit to see relatives in N.C. when he died. The home where he and Sarah lived was still standing in 1910. It had been remodeled and a second story had been added. He and Sarah are buried in the cemetery at Gun Branch near their old home in S.C. Children were: Maria - Judith - Penelope Moore - Sarah Jane - Elisabeth - Mary Catherine - Silas and Jerusha Holloman.

1. Jerusha - died as a'baby

- 2. Silas died at the age of 6 or 7
- 3. Maria Born May 15, 1822 died Feb. , 1892 She married Abram Blackwell in May 1844 - Children were:
  - A. Victoria married a Asborn or Asbarn
  - B. Henry married died May 1, 1884 He left a wife and little girl - they were living in Orange County, Fla. in 1882
  - C. Lola married a Jordan
  - D. John do not know anything about him

After Blackwell's death, Maria married a man by the name of Holland - No children were born to them. She was living in Ala. when married to Holland. She was on a visit to S.C., when she died.

4. Judith - Born May 12, 1824 - died June 12, 1885 - married John Hood Wilson Nov. 10, 1839 in Darlington Co., S.C. (He died Feb. 3, 1884). They moved to Macon County, Ala. between the years of 1845 and 1848 - settled 11 miles west of a small town Cotton Valley and 4 miles east of Mongomery, Ala. In the winter of 1858 and 1859 moved to Walker Co., Texas. He was a Baptist minister. Children were:

- A. Sarah born July 17, 1841 Darlington Co., S.C. died in Sept. 1845
- B. Mary born Nov. 5, 1843, Darlington Co., S.C. died Oct. 2, 1849 in Macon Co., Ala.
- C. Joseph David born Aug. 14, 1845 died April 14, 1912, Grimes Co., Tex. - married Emily P. Walker
- D. Penelope Ann born March 18, 1848, Macon Co., Ala., died May 25, 1924, Grimes Co., Tex - Married Oliver Smith
- E. Catherine Elisabeth born May 14, 1850, Macon Co., Ala. died May 31, 1912, Grimes Co., Tex. - married Green B. Johnson
- F. Silas Henry born Sept. 26, 1852, Macon Co., Ala. died Oct. 25, 1936-Grimes Co., Tex. - married Zillah May Bullard
- 6. Mary Jane born Nov. 9, 1854, Macon Co., Ala died Jan. 4, 1940 Grimes Co., Tex. - married John Thomas Adams
- H. Alexander Carson born Dec. 16, 1856, Macon Co., Ala. died March 19, 1943, Grimes Co., Tex. - married Araminta Woodbury
- I. John Hood born Feb. 25, 1859, Walker Co., Tex. married twice no children - died

J. Sarah Adella - born July 18, 1861 - died Jan 7, 1943, Grimes Co. Tex. - married William Manly Eliza Josephine - born April 22, 1864, Walker Co., Tex. - died Κ. July 24, 1865 Eliza Lucretia - born Dec. 17, 1866, Walker Co., Tex. died Dec. L. 31, 1886 - married B.W. Bullard M. Lula Sehoy - born Oct. 27, 1869-Walker Co. Tex-died Oct. 28, 1948married Richard Beauregard Harrison-Children: 1. Lula Ethel - born Aug. 1, 1900 - married Travis Corley - Children: a. Thyra Evelyn - born Feb. 13, 1922 - marr. Children were: (Annie died Jan. 25, 1885) 1. Ellie, Carroll, John and James Edwin John Blackwell died during the Civil War - then Penelope married William Henry Hearon (who was a widower) - Children: 8.
