As I have already stated, my mind is blank on Old Dobbs news at this time.



Be it remembred that on ye 28th day of August in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Eight John Robertson & his Wife Peggy Robertson Personally came before me Benj. Exum Esq. one of the Justices assigned to keep the peace in & for the County aforesaid and acknowledged themselves indebted to his Excellency Richard Caswell Esqn. Governor & his Successors, in the Sum of Two Thousand pounds to be Levied of their goods Chattells Lands & Tenements respectively to the use of the said State upon Condition that if the above Bounded John Robertson and Peggy Robertson shall Personally Appear at the Next Supr. Court to be held for the District of New Bern in the Town of New Bern on ye Twentieth day of Novr. Next then and their to give Evidence in Behalf of the State against Thos. Butcher and that they do not depart the Court without Leave thereof then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force Strength & Virtue. Acknowledged before
