Notes from all over:

From my FOA newsletter; George Stephenson, Supervisor of the State Archives Search Room is leaving on a six-month research trip to Scotland in mid-June. He will be working in the Scottish Public Record Office for the Colonial Records Project searching for and copying documents relating to pre-Revolutionary North Carolina. He expects to return to duty in the Search Room about the middle of November.

This Colonial Records Project is one little know facet of our State Archives and the same kind of work is going on in England. Again we live up to our state motto, To be rather than to seem, by constantly up-grading the material that we have available for researchers.

Dr. Thornton W. Mitchell, former N. C. Archivist, is currently working on an update of the wills of the Colonial period. He is using surviving originals as well as will books and the records of the Sec. of State. He has told me that he has found many wills that have been omitted from both Grimes & Olds works. No date has been given for publication but we hope it won't be too long. This will be a major work and one that is long overdue.

My National Genealogical Society Newsletter arrived today and imagine my surprise to find Wayne Co. Listed... The 3rd Annual Meeting of the Peacock Family Association will be held in Thomasville, Ga. on 22-23 of June. A special invitation is extended to descendants of Robert Peacock of Wayne Co., N.C. Our Registrar of Deeds, Margaret Peacock, has done it again! She has copied, on

Archival paper, all surviving marriage license applications. They are much easier to use and help to preserve the originals. The county has offered the Society the chance to copy those to 1900 (this matches the date of the marriage register that the Society copied). This would also be available at the library and perhaps we could even run them in the newsletter.

This, however, brings up a point that our Treasurer made to me this week. Due to the increased size of our newsletter we spent more than we made in dues this past year. Editor's Note: Laban & Urbin Lewis were sons of William Lewis, a Revolutionary War soldier born in Dobbs County and died in Cumberland Co. in 1841. Gift deeds are recorded to these two sons in Wayne County.
