The following material was sent in by James Ingram, these are all from Wayne County Deed Books. Given first is the book number followed by the page number.

4,42: Franky Martin to Samuel Harrill to raise my three children, Richard, Bitha & Sally Martin-1/2 tract of land belonging to Richard Martin dec'd. Wits. J. Atkinson, John Flowers, and Amos Walker.

4,43: 7 Jan 1788 Richard Caswell to Solomon Pope-formerly in Craven Co., now Wayne-North Side of Neuse-491 acres-which land sd. R. Caswell claims under the grant of George Roberts, Esq. from the late King George 3 Mar 1738 for 2000 acres, also one other tract the sd. George Roberts for 1000 acres 5 June 1739-R. Caswell and John Herritage Surviving Executors of the last will & testament of William Herritage, dec'd, sold & conveyed to Martin Caswell the 3 Jan instant & by the sd. Martin Caswell the same day to Richard Caswell. Wits. Thomas Gray, James Cobb.

4,51: 2 Jan 1788-Soloman Herring and wife Jane to Joseph Green-300 acres grant to Robert Rielly 20 Apr 1740 & descended by heirship from Robert Rielly to Jane Rielly, dau. of sd. R. Rielly, now wife of Solomon Herring.

4,85: William Fellow for love and affection niece Anne McKinnie one negro girl named Margaret. 15 Apr 1788. Wits. Richard McKinnie and Thos. Costella.

4,142: Rachel Hines to dau. Selvey Hines, miscellaneous property. Wits. Benjamin Herring, Jacob Herring

4,297: 14 Aug 1788- Joseph Shaw to Lewis Jernigan-right, title, etc.-2 negroes which formerly belonged to Joseph Jernigan, dec'd. Wits: John Westbrook, Ann Holmes.

4,387 9 May 1789 John Pickren to sons; Charles W., John, Garoldos, Spencer, Moses T., one negro wench.

4,387: Sarah Crow to son-in-law Solomon Barfield, one negro woman. Wits: Rachel Ingram.

4,390: 25 Sept 1789 Sarah Crow to son-in-law Ephraim Bradshaw negro boy Simon. Wits: D. Cogdell

4,440: Joseph Hatch-Jones Co & Ann Hatch his wife and dau. of Richard Blackledge, dec'd of Craven Co. to Joel Herring for 20 barrells of pork 148 acres granted to Joseph Balik (?) 26 June 1748 & conveyed to Peter Knight & to Richard Blackledge & left by him to Ann Hatch.

5,21: 26 Oct 1792 James Manly lend unto my wife Mary one negro girl after wife dec'd I give unto my dau-in-law Mary Ingram sd. negro girl. Wits: Wm. Ingram, Jethro Odom, James Rapkel (?), Benjamin Hutson.

5,53: 15 Jan 1794 Sarah Crow to son Isaac Crow one negro, Jack. Wits: Thomas Crow, Rueben Elmore.

5,55: 14 Dec 1793: John Atkinson give unto Jonna Crow the bed & furniture I now lye on & to her dau. Sarah Crow my other bed, chest, livestock, house, etc. Wits: Soloman Barfield, Rueben Elmore.

5,78: Trojan Whitfield to dau. Sarah Fonville one negro girl, Mary 14 Apr 1794 Wits: Buckner Killebrew, Mary Killebrew.

5,107: 14 Jan 1794 William Ham to dau. Kezia Ham, 2 negroes. Wits: John Sphan, Rich'd Hamm.

5, 143: 22 Oct 1794 James Manly to dau. Mary Westbrook negroes. Wits: Vincent Salman.

5,143: James Manly to son-in-law John Westbrook negroes. Wits: Rueben Littleton, Rd. Fulghum, ??????

5,186: 25 Sept 1789 Sarah Crow to dau. Rachel Ingram my property except gift to Soloman Barfield, Ephraim Crow, Isaac Crow, John Crow. Wits: David Cogdell.

5,187: John Perry to grandchildren, children of my daughter, Mary Stokes wife of David Stokes.

5,190: James Manly of Wayne to Elick Avery & Thomas Ingram of Cumberland Co. one negro man Sam & feather bed. 26 Dec 1794. Wits: David Cogdell.

5,225: Thomas Thomas to wife Marv. after her death to

James Ingram, who lives in Oxford sent me 9 legal sheets with information that he found in the deed books that prove relationships, and some of it will be in this issue, with the rest at a later date. My thanks to both of them for sharing their research efforts.

Through our exchange program with other counties who are publishing Heritage Books we have received the Rutherford County Heritage Book. It will be available shortly in the local history room.

Since many of our members may not have ready access to the published 1790 census I have transcribed it onto the census forms. We will begin running in this issue the 1790 census. I am also indexing it and when we finish with the census itself we will run the index. I am also doing the 1800 census and when we finish the 1790 we will run the 1800 which will be printed in alphabetical order. As time permits me I will continue with this indexing program.

Also in this issue will be the addresses of the various church archives in the state. Do remember that most of these archives do not have the staff to do unlimited research, but generally if you make your request for a specific item they will be happy to help. If their staff is too limited to do any such searches they will supply you with a list of researchers who specialize in their records. Do remember to send an SASE when you contact a church.

My thanks to Mary Spiron who has agreed to take on the task of seeing that the issues of the newsletter are run off and mailed. It has been an increasingly time consuming job. Now I only have to do the master and get it to her. Again my thanks Mary!

5,320: 8 Jan 1796 James Manly to dau. Hanner Coor-negro.

5,321: 27 Aug 1795 Kizah Alston to brother Benj. Alston, to Elizabeth Reaves, Peggy Reaves, Elizabeth Cox, Nancy Bennett-rest divide between Judah Parish, Alie Brown, Nancy Burnet, Polly Slokim. Wits: Wm. Bennett, Elijah Carraway.

5,325: 10 Nov 1794 Ruffin DeLoach of Territory of the South of the River Ohio & Co. of Sumner-to James & Jesse Musgrave of Wayne Co. sd. Ruffin DeLoach, heir of Richard Ruffin & guardian of Thomas & Polly DeLoach a plantation in Wayne Co. ---land patented to John Sessions 26 Sept 1766. Wits; Uriah Bass, Jesse Blanshard.

The 1790 census has five columns for data, the first one is for Free White Males age 16 and up, the second one is Free White Males under 16, the third is Free White Females including the head of household, the fourth is All Other Persons (this is the listing for free blacks and Indians), the last one is Slaves.
