## "Mineral Springs"

My Great Aunt, Martha Sugg Dixon 1827-1904, wrote the following:
"Seasonally Papa's family (Dr. Aquilla Sugg 1803-184山 and Mary Sugg, his wife) would move down from their working farm to a small house at the Mineral Springs. Grandma Patsy (Martha Aldridge Sugg 1762-after 1820) was quite fond of this little house and resort and called their place Brighton after the resort in England. The springs, the large groves and the profusion of laurel and Jasmine, and bay, made it a Paradise safe from the summer heat. The springs, themselves, were valued for their medicinal qualities and became quite a resort for the local society, many of whom also kept small establishments near-by. For those who did not keep houses there, old Col. Smith (James "Jim Smith) built a number of cottages there which could be rented by visitors.

Fish Feast, Arbor Dances, and Picnics were held here in great numbers during the partying season, and there were always horse races, cards, and much partying and visiting amongest friends and relations. With easier travel and more sophistication amongest the locals, these springs went out of vogue as more people went to the springs in Virginia and the Carolina upcountry."

In the North Carolina Gazetteer by William S. Powell is the following 1
Mineral Springs, located in south Greene County on the old Jim Smith plantation. There is a high ridge on the south side of the creek (Great Contentnea) and the springs are on the slope of this hill. They were formerly quite popular as a source of supposedly healthful waters. Several acres of adjacent lowlands are covered with laurel which blooms beautifully every apring."

My earliest memory of this place was when I was attending school at Snow Hill and the children in the Hookerton area would bring some of the laurel flowers for our class room. I was born 30 May 1912.
